

Steps to Change a Starter Motor

- 1. Turn off the ignition and open the hood.
- 2. Remove the negative battery cable from the battery.
- 3. Remove the positive cable (the large cable that runs to the battery) from the starter.
- 4. **Disconnect all the bolts** that hold the starter to the block, using a ratchet.
- 5. Remove any other supporting brackets holding the starter in place.
- 6. Remove all the shield and bolts holding the starter. Don't force any bolts that are very tight and are difficult to remove. Rather, use a lubricant or grease to help you loosen the bolt.
- 7. Remove the starter from the car.
- 8. Reinstall in reverse order.
- 9. Close the hood and pat yourself on the back!
